### 2 Registration Fee Issue

For issues raised by A. Noda, IPAC10 SPC Chair, the committee has discussed and suggestions are made as follows:

- (1) Next Asian IPAC committee will be informed on this matter in advance, so that Russian representative from Siberian region will be properly counted.
- (2) Issue on registration fee to retired participant will be decided by LOC, not by ACFA. Status of retired or not of individual participant will be determined with the help of OC and SPC members who know the situation well.

After three reports, general discussions were followed. Key items discussed or suggested were following.

- (1) Decision related with IPAC (Asian turn) and ALCSC, and the promoting accelerator construction in Asia are still major role of ACFA.
- (2) Regional activities for specified fields are growing fast (e.g. Asia Oceania Forum for Synchrotron Radiation). This kind of activity is always encouraged, but their being independence from ACFA is not what we want. We need further discussion on this matter.
- (3) If Joint Accelerator Workshop at Beijing will continue to be held among major accelerator countries in Asia, ACFA strongly suggests that this will be prepared under the name of ACFA. On this matter, ACFA representative will discuss with workshop organizers during the workshop.
- (4) Next ACFA meeting will be held during IPAC10 at Kyoto. ACFA will ask IPAC10 organizer to provide proper time slot and a room for next ACFA meeting.
- (5) The minutes of this meeting will be distributed among participants of 15<sup>th</sup> ACFA meeting to finalize. The final minutes will be distributed to all ACFA members and all presentation materials will be appeared at ACFA home page.
